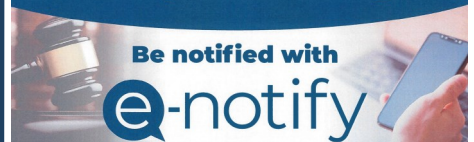

## Worried you'll miss a hearing?

E-Notify allows individuals to register to receive alerts of upcoming criminal court events via text or email. The system is intended to keep defendants and any other interested parties informed about upcoming court events.

Why wait in line? Our Official Records Division offers a convenient drop-off service. If you are paying by check, you can just drop the documents at the counter. ## Getting Married?

Complete your Marriage License Application online and save valuable time. Once submitted, the parties can simply stop by the Courthouse or the Hobe Sound branch office and proceed directly to a clerk to review and issue the license.
